



We owe it to kids to report child abuse.

If you have any suspicions that a child is suffering from abuse or neglect, please don't hesitate. Report suspected abuse immediately to your local law enforcement agency or child protective services. You are not required to provide proof. Oregon law protects people who make good-faith reports of child abuse from prosecution and/or liability. When you call, you may be asked the following:

1. The child's name
2. The suspected perpetrator's name (if known)
3. What you have seen or heard
4. Names of others who know about the abuse
